## Series Information

### **To Qualify for 2021 Championships:**

1. MUST be a current NEJA member.
2. MUST show in at least 2 NEJA shows at the level you wish to qualify for.
3. **POINTS:** You need to acquire a minimum of 4 points to qualify in the division you want to compete in for the Championships. Points are acquired through competing and placing in classes. View points system for more information.
4. **Finals Prize list, entry form and more information will be posted closer to the end of the season.**

### **General Show Season Information:**

**Entries:** Entries close ONE WEEK before the date of the show. All entries must MAILED in with proof of coggins and rabies & payment. Entries that are received incomplete will not be counted or accepted until they are complete, and are subjected to an additional processing fee.

**Show Fees:** All Classes, unless started otherwise, will be \$20 per round for the 2021 jumper series. Entries are complete by rider/horse combination. Each entry MUST PAY: ground fee, office fee and respectable class fees. Non NEJA Members must pay a “non-member fee”. Entries submitted after the close date are subject to a post entry fee of \$35.00.

**ADD/DROPS:** Adding and dropping classes must be done at the SHOW OFFICE. Add/Drops must be completed before classes start. Riders dropping a class after it has been started will still be subject to paying the class fees.

Entries that are mailed in with payment but not full payment will not receive their riding number until dues are paid in full, no exceptions.

**Awards:** Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Place in all regular classes offered. Specialty classes may differ in ribbons 1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> place with prizes.

**Refunds:** NEJA will NOT offer refunds under any circumstances after the closing date, no exceptions. (THIS APPLIES FOR ALL EVENTS)

**Coggins/Vaccination Requirements:** Proof of rabies within 12 months, and negative Coggins within 12 months.

**Show Attire:** White show shirt, or show Jacket with Tan or white pants with tall boots.

**Other:** NO DOGS ARE PERMITTED TO BE ON SHOW GROUNDS AT ANYTIME

**Prize Money:** Prize money can be given to winner in two ways, either mailed check after the show or deduct from rider's balance at the end of the show. Prize money will only be awarded with classes of 8 or more horses. Classes can run with less than 8 but no prize money will be awarded.

**Show Conduct:** NEJA shows will be run under a strict code of conduct. Riders will be found in poor standing if any of the following occur:

- A) Blatant disregard of the rules and safety.
- B) Failure to make good on insufficient funds within 60 days.
- C) Rude or Disrespectful behavior toward other competitors or event staff (Including Judge & Steward).
- D) The use of abusive or foul language toward anyone or any animal.
- E) Disregard for the well-being of the horse.
- F) Any bullying of any kind
- G) Destruction of show grounds or property of any kind (this includes not cleaning up after your horse)

\* If not compliant with show conduct, the show grounds and association have power to ban rider from events for up to a year at a time. We will have a **ZERO TOLERANCE** rule for inappropriate show conduct, these rules apply to all riders, spectators and all show participants.

.70m Jumper -- 2'3"  
.80m Jumper -- 2'7"  
.90m Jumper -- 2'10"  
1.00m Jumper -- 3'3"  
1.10m Jumper -- 3'7"  
1.15m Jumper -- 3'9"  
1.20m Jumper -- 3'11"  
1.25m Jumper -- 4'1"  
1.30m Jumper -- 4'3"  
1.35m Jumper -- 4'5"  
1.40m Jumper -- 4'7"  
1.45m Jumper -- 4'9"  
1.50m Jumper -- 4'11"



**Gambler Choice:** There will be 12-15 jumps in the arena dedicated to this class, all the jumps will be set at different heights ranging between 2'3" - 3', every jump will be worth a certain amount of points, riders will NOT be told the amount of points each jump is worth. Riders will get 35 seconds to jump as many jumps as they can. If a rider has a rail within their 35 seconds it will NOT count against them, but they only get points for the jumps they go clear over. After the rider's time is up, they will have a choice to jump the "Gamblers Jump" which will be set at an unknown height, the jump is worth 10 points if you go clear, BUT if you have a rail on that jump it counts against you -10 Points.

**\*\*(Table II, Sec (c)):** SPEED ROUND, one course of 10-15 Jump which the riders are judged on fastest time with fewest faults

**\*\*(Table II, Sec (b)):** JUMP-OFF ROUND, Two rounds. First round of 10-15 jumps which each rider has to jump clear in the first round in order to advance to the Jump Off. If rider is clear, they advance to the jump off which is 4-8 jumps where the riders are judged on fastest time with fewest faults.

## Memberships & Year End Awards

### 1. Memberships:

- Membership is open to all.
- The year is defined as Jan 1st to December 31<sup>st</sup>.
- A junior rider is defined as any rider 17 yrs. or younger. A junior's age is defined as the age of the junior on Jan 1<sup>st</sup> of the membership year.
- Membership types and fees are defined as Individual 1 year (\$50).
  - Memberships purchased before February 1<sup>st</sup> will receive a discounted rate, \$45 for memberships received before Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>.

2. Year End Awards will be as follows:

- Jumper divisions, awards will be given 1st through 8th place. All divisions offered at NEJA shows are eligible for year-end awards.
- For horse and rider points to count, only the rider needs to be an NEJA Member, but the owner's information and consent must be given with membership form.
- For a leased horse, the lessee will be considered the owner for point-counting purposes.
- NEW POINT OPPORTUNITY: **“Young Horse Program”**. NEJA will be offering a Young Horse Program, young horses are defined as the following, 3 years old to 6 years old. Rider of said horse needs to establish proof of horses age and be an NEJA Member in order to be eligible. Young horses can earn points in any classes offered and it will count in a separate age division in the year end award points.

Riders will receive a comment card from the judge after the class is closed. This is an opportunity for riders to get another opinion from an outside source to help with their future rounds.

Speed Derby: One timed first round and no jump-off. Riders and horses must negotiate the course as quickly and accurately as possible without lowering any rails to be the winner. Faults are to be converted into time. (4 faults = 4 added seconds to your time)

Team Challenge: Teams are to be made up of three rider/horse combinations. Teams will run a set course and tag out (their team members) like a relay race. Team rounds will be judged off speed derby rules, fastest time with faults converted.
