## **To Qualify:**

1. MUST be a current NEJA member.
2. MUST show in at least 2 NEJA Shows at the level you wish to qualify for.
3. POINTS: Rider must acquire points in the height or division they wish to compete in, a minimum of 6 points is needed to qualify. Qualifying horse may be swapped if there is a medical reason, vet note required.

## **General Information:**

**Ribbons:** Places 1<sup>st</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> place. 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive a prize/prize money. Sponsored classes could receive a prize donated by the sponsoring company. Regular classes will receive ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> -6<sup>th</sup> place.

**Arena:** 150x300, GGT footing

**Food:** Food truck will be on the grounds the day of the event.

**Classes:** Regular Jumping classes, #40-45 are open to all members and non members wishing to compete. Regular classes will run as normal. All Championship classes are open to members who have qualified prior to this event. Championship classes will have a ribbon presentation & ceremony.

**Entries:** Entries close October 5<sup>th</sup>, entries received after close date will be charged a \$35 late fee. Entries MUST be mailed, paid in full, and have correct and UTD vaccination records.

**Show Attire:** Jackets, tan, or white pants with tall boots (lead line exception). Braids are not required but are encouraged. NO EXCEPTIONS to proper riding attire.
