Dressage: 20 x 60m Indoor arena. Warm up 20x40 indoor area.

SJ: If weather is good show jumping will be in an outdoor sand ring. If condition are not ideal it will be in the Indoor Area. (after dressage ends, we will set up jumps in the indoor)

Awards: Ribbons 1st - 6th, Prizes for division winners.
